Specific fundraising drives

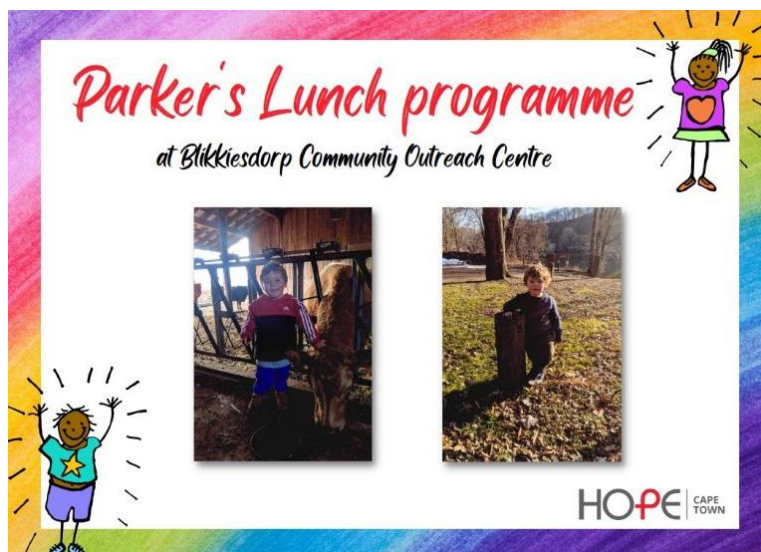
